FLAG CONTEST GUIDELINES

Join in the fun as we Commemorate America's **250th anniversary** and celebrate **Chestnut Hill** with flags created by you! Flags will be displayed in the shops along the avenue from Flag Day June 14 – July 31, 2026 and published in the Chestnut Hill Local

Theme: **Commemoration of America's 250th Anniversary & Celebration of Chestnut Hill**

Three Categories to select from for your flag:

Garden District – Chestnut Hill Red, White Blue and You Community and Culture

There will be a winner from each age group for each category

Design Requirements:

- Final Artwork size 11 inches x 17 inches
- Include a pole or stick to support flag - recommended length 24 – 30 inches
- Landscape orientation preferred
- Colors: bold, high contrast - avoid fine gradients/shading
- Materials – use your imagination beyond pens, paint and pencils – can use 3D items
- Imagery to align with one of the 3 Design Categories referencing the 250th Anniversary and Chestnut Hill
- Complexity: Designs must be visually clear at 6 - 10 feet (avoid small details)
- Distinctive interpretation of flag

Submission Labeling and Return

- Label your flag submission with your name and contact information including email and cell phone/phone
- Your flag will be available for you to pick up beginning August 1st at:
